2. Application for merit and/or leadership and diversity scholarships may be submitted *only during the senior year of high school*.

4. To be considered for any scholarship, you must be admitted as a matriculated (degree-seeking) student. An *Application for Undergraduate Admission* is included in the University's *Application Materials* packet, available from the University of Utah, Admissions Office, 201 S. 1460 E., Rm. 250S, Salt Lake City, UT 84112-9057, (801) 581-7281. **December 15, is the preferred filing date for admission to the University of Utah.**
5. If you earn an ACT or SAT score higher than the score with which you were admitted, submit an official copy of the higher score with your scholarship application. You must take the SAT or the ACT by December in order to qualify for this award.
6. Keep copies of your applications. If you do not receive acknowledgement of receipt of this application, call (801) 581-6211.

Include in this essay the challenges you have faced in preparing for college.
