

## **Next Steps**

- Monitor your Campus Information Services (CIS)/UMail Account and respond to requests promptly
- Complete Verification if selected
- Accept/Decline Financial Aid in Campus Information Services (CIS)
- Complete Master Promissory Note (MPN) and entrance counseling if accepting loans – <u>studentloans.gov</u>



### Next Steps (Continued)

- Check the students tuition bill a few weeks before classes begin
  - Tuition bill can change if classes are added or dropped
- Direct Deposit for Refunds
  - Go to <u>cis.utah.edu</u>, log in with the student ID and password, click the Tuition and Loans Tile, then the Direct Deposit Authorization Form.
  - Form can be completed in the Financial Aid Award Letter
  - A check will be sent to the mailing address in listed in Campus
     Information Services if the student does not sign up for direct deposit
- Financial Aid and Scholarship disbursements occur the first week of the semester.



## Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

- Form is in CIS FERPA Consent to Release tile
- Student must select the type of information that may be disclosed
- Create a PIN/Password
- Enter the name, relationship, and email address of every individual he/she wishes to give access to

Note: FERPA authorizes the institution to release student information, but it does not require the institution to do so



FERPA NOTICE: The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), governs the release of records maintained by an institution of higher education and access to student records, including requests for information from parents, guardians, spouses, or others as designated by the student. Cenerally, without a student's written consent, the University of Utah may not disclose information from a student's educational records. Students who want to allow information released to individuals, or who want to receive information, about their Financial Aid, Scholarships, Tuttion, Registrar Records, Housing Residential Education, or Academic Advising (University College/Departmental and College Advisors) Records over the telephone, in person, or electronically must complete this declaration form providing a standing release to the University to disclose education information from the offices you designate below.

I understand that picture ID is REQUIRED when any information is requested in person at the various University offices. I also understand by authorizing communication to the Email accounts listed below, I do so at my own risk and the University of Ulah, the University offices are not responsible for the security of the information.

- I give The University Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid, Income Accounting, and Student Loan Services Office permission to release information regarding the processing and delivery of my financial aid and scholarships and financial/fultion information to myself and any individual(s) listed below with the appropriate PIN.
- I give the University of Utah Office of the Registrar permission to release information about my educational record information to myself and any individual(s) listed below with the appropriate PIN.
- I give the University of Utah Academic Advising Center and Departmental/College Advisers permission to release information maintained by the Academic Advising Offices about my educational record information to myself and any individual(s) listed below with the appropriate PIN.
- I give the University of Utah Housing & Residential Education Office permission to release information regarding my housing financial account, its status and charges listed on my account to myself and any individual(s) listed below with the appropriate PIN.
- I give the University of Utah International Student & Scholar Services and Learning Abroad Offices permission to release information maintained by their offices about my educational record information to myself and any individual(s) listed below with the appropriate PIN.

#### Scholarship Checks from Private Organizations

- If a student is receiving a scholarship from a private organization, the check must be sent to the University Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid – mailed or dropped off in person.
- The check must include identifying information student's name and the student ID number
- Checks will be applied to the student's tuition account
- Processing time is one week



#### **Paying Tuition**

- All students are responsible for paying tuition by the tuition deadline
- Tuition bill can change if classes are added or dropped
- Fall 2018 tuition deadline is Friday, August 31
- Spring 2019 tuition deadline is Friday, January 19
- Check the tuition bill in Campus Information Services (CIS) before classes start

#### Payment Options

- Credit Card/Debit Card
  - \$3.00 fee will apply
  - Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and American Express accepted
  - Pay Online
    - Campus Information Services (CIS)
    - Finance Section, Tuition Bill/Pay Tuition
  - Pay at the cashier's window, Student Services Building, first floor
- Cash or a check
  - Pay by E-check (also available online)
  - Pay at the cashier's window, Student Services Building, first floor
  - Payment drop box is available



### Late Fees and Dropped Classes

- Students with a FAFSA on file will not receive late fees
- If you have accepted financial aid, your classes will not be dropped.
- Still need help paying tuition?
  - Short Term Loans and Deferral of Tuition options available through the Income Accounting Office

#### Funding Your Education Beyond the First Year (continued)

- Complete the FAFSA every year
  - Available Oct. 1
  - Priority Date: Feb. 1
  - Grants, Need-Based Scholarships, Work-Study, Loans
  - fafsa.gov
- Scholarships outside of the University of Utah
  - Online Scholarship Resources on the University Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid Website
  - Deadlines and requirements vary
- Helpful Hints
  - Be organized keep track of deadlines and scholarship requirements
  - Make time to apply for scholarships
  - Get involved on campus Examples: ASUU, Bennion Center, Business Scholars
  - Utilize campus resources Writing Center, academic advisors, financial aid counselors,
     Student Success Advocates, Center for Ethnic Student Affairs (CESA)




#### Funding Your Education Beyond the First Year
